- Ensuring that all clinical and behavioral interventions, programs, and services provided through the Psychology Department are scientifically- and ethically-based, and consistent with current standards, guidelines, and principles in the field of psychology and behavioral analysis.
- Ensure overall effectiveness of psychological services, including the coordination of psychological services with other services at the facility.

Additionally:

- Chair and administer Psychology Department committees, such as the Behavior Management Committee and various facility committees.
- Collaborate with interdisciplinary teams.
- Directly manage and supervise a team of psychologists and coordinate duties of psychological assistants with Treatment Program Services.
- Direct, design, and provide intra- and inter-department in-service training to professional and paraprofessional staff.
- Plan and direct the intra- and inter-departmental training program for new and existing employees to orient them to the Psychology Department, its practices, expectations, and goals.

At GRC, we strive to provide holistic treatment utilizing the multidisciplinary model in an integrated approach to service provision. A person-centered approach is our goal in
